# Supplementary Regulations – Requirements for Roverkhana

## Event permit number: 319/0906/02

### 1. The Event

- a. The Roverkhana Motorkhana event, hereafter shall be referred to as Roverkhana, is a club-only event.
- b. Roverkhana does not form any part of the Rover Scout Motorsport Championship Series for 2018/19 or overall Mudbash results.

### 2. Place and Date

- . Roverkhana will be conducted at Mafeking Rover Park on Saturday 8 June 2019.

### 3. Entries

Entries will open on the publication of these regulations and close at 9am on Saturday 8 June 2019.

- . Entries will only be accepted from current members of Rover Scout Motorsport.
- a. CAMS licences must be presented at check in.
- b. The competitive entry cost will be \$10 per driver.
- c. The maximum number of entries will be 25 Crews or 250 drivers, accepted in order of receipt.
- d. Entry forms are to be completed in full, including signatures.  
All entries that have been accepted will be notified in writing and if required, any further regulations may be sent out at the same time.
- e. The promoter reserves the right to refuse an entry in accordance with NCR 83.

### 4. Insurance

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au).

### 5. Classes

- a. There is 1 class: Production Motorkhana

### 6. Starting Order

- . Competitors shall be advised of the starting order prior to the event.
- a. Vehicles will start Roverkhana from a stationary position, within the start garage in a forward facing direction.

### 7. Competitors

- . All drivers that are participating in Roverkhana must be the holder of at least a CAMS level 1 competition licence.

### 8. Driver's Briefing And Alcohol Breath Test

It is compulsory for all competitors to attend, driver briefings and alcohol breath test on the day of competition and must be present for a roll-call. Any competitor who is not present for a roll-call will be ineligible to compete.

- I. Any amendments to the driver briefing, including notification of track conditions and other points of relevance to the specific courses, will be posted on the Notice Boards in the Harold Gardiner Rover Hall and the Service Park Hot Works Shed 30 minutes prior to the tracks advertised start time.
- II. Alcohol Breath Tests will be conducted 3 times a day as well as random breath tests.

## 9. Scrutiny

Scrutiny will take place at Mafeking Rover Park on **Friday 7 June 2019**, between the hours of **7pm and 11pm**. Scrutiny will recommence on **Saturday 8 June 2019** at **7:00am through to 9:00am**. Scrutiny will only be provided outside of these times at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer.

A \$50 deposit (cash only, no change supplied), to ensure the cleanliness of the pit bays, is required to be paid to the Scrutineer upon presentation of each vehicle to scrutiny. Please place the deposit in an unsealed envelope with Crew name and Crew contact number clearly written on the front. The deposit will be returned to the Crew on Monday, once pit bays have been cleared by the delegated Committee member/s. Deposit collection will be from HQ. Adequate bin (50L recommended) and 3 garbage bags must be present in the vehicle when presented to scrutiny.

- . All competing vehicles must comply with schedules A and Group 4H of the CAMS Manual.
- a. Crews must present their vehicles in full competition trim
  - I. Competitors are required apparel including helmets that is compliance with Schedule D 1.4 Khanacross
  - II. Competitors are required to have appropriate neck braces, safety helmets.
  - III. Safety helmets must conform to Cams requirements (eg AS1689) and to be worn while competing.
  - IV. Open faced safety helmets must be worn with goggles.
  - V. All competing vehicles must have one coloured cable tie attached on the drivers side of the car.
- b. Vehicles must arrive to the Event and be presented at scrutiny in a clean and tidy condition, ensuring no foreign plant or earth matter enters Mafeking Rover Park. Vehicles deemed not to comply with this requirement by the Scrutineers or Clerk of Course will not be scrutineered or allowed to start the Event as appropriate.
- c. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions, as per the RSM Standing Regulations.
- d. No vehicle is to be started before 7am. All vehicles must be in the service park and motor off by 11pm.
- e. If any vehicles arrive after 11pm Friday night, they must remain on the trailer until 7am Saturday morning, at which point they will partake in Event scrutiny.

## 10. Competition and Layout

- A. Roverkhana shall commence at 9am on Saturday 8 June 2019.

## 11. Awards

- . A trophy will be awarded to first, second and third outright.

I/We being the entrant/s of the vehicle described on this Entry Form wish to enter that vehicle for the above event.

### For Competitors and Drivers

I/We being the competitors and or drivers, certify that the particulars on this form are true and correct in every particular, to the best of my/our knowledge and belief. I/We declare that I/we have read and understood the Supplementary Regulations issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them and the provisions of the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited ("**CAMS**"). In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the event (including entering the event), I/ we agree:

- To release CAMS and Australian Motor Sport Commission Ltd, promoters, sponsor organisations, competitors, entrants, land owners and lessees, organisers of the event, their respective servants, officials, representatives and agents (collectively, the "**Associated Entities**") from all liability for my death, personal injury (including burns), psychological trauma, loss or damage (including property damage) ("**harm**") howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the event, whether caused by the negligence of any of the Associated Entities or otherwise;

I understand that this disclaimer is not intended to exclude any valid claim I may have under the CAMS Personal Insurance Scheme.

I have had sufficient opportunity to read this Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement, fully understand its terms, understand I have given up substantial rights by signing it and sign it freely and voluntarily, without inducement of any kind.
