

**Rover Scout Motorsport**  
**Administration Policy**  
**OFFICIAL AWARD**

This policy covers the selection process and awarding of the Rover Scout Motorsport Club Official of the Year Award, otherwise known as the RSM Officials Award.

**Award Description:**

The Rover Scout Motorsport Club Official of the Year Award is awarded to an individual member who has taken on a role of an Official (Non- Key Official Role) at one or more RSM events and displayed fairness, sportsmanship and professionalism.

**Award Criteria:**

The criteria for Nominees are as follows:

- Can be any RSM Member – Rover or Ex-Rover,
- Demonstrates values of fair play and equality,
- Demonstrates exceptional sportsmanship,
- Demonstrates professionalism in their chosen/designated role,
- Hold any role at an RSM event (Senior/Key Officials may be nominated but non-Key Official Nominations will received greater preference),
- Be an excellent ambassador for Rovers and Rover Scout Motorsport in the eyes of Club Members and outside personnel alike.

**Nomination Process:**

Only Completed Nomination Forms will be accepted and they must be sent to the RSM Committee via one of two methods by the last Friday of JULY.
